Who is the administrator of your personal data?

GDPR – short information

The GDPR (Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data) grants you, among others, the following rights related to the processing of your personal data:

1. the right to access your data and receive a copy of it,
2. the right to rectify (correct) your data,
3. the right to delete data processed unjustifiably,
4. the right to restriction of data processing (you can request that the processing of data be limited only to their storage or to the performance of activities agreed with you),
5. the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (if you find that we process your data unlawfully, you can lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection or another competent supervisory authority).

The rules related to the exercise of the above-mentioned rights are described in detail in Articles 16 – 21 of the GDPR.

Where do we get your data from and why do we process it

Where do we get your data from: you could provide us with your data by filling in the contact form on the www.lambdasystem.pl website, by e-mail or phone. We were also able to obtain them during direct business contacts, e.g. at scientific or industry conferences

For what purpose do we process your data: we process your data in order to handle your orders or other obligations resulting from the contract between us, to issue an invoice and include it in accounting documentation, for statistical purposes and direct marketing of our own products and services.

What data do we process: data necessary to complete the order, i.e.: name and surname, billing address, company data, e-mail address, telephone number, VAT ID number.

How long We store data: the time necessary to process the order, and then until the expiry of the limitation period for claims under the concluded contract. After this period, the data may still be processed by us for archiving purposes or direct marketing of our own products and services until an objection is raised.

Who we share your personal data with Your

data may be processed by third parties who provide us with services to support our business. The data provided is processed only to the extent necessary.

Entities to which data may be transferred:

1. entities operating IT systems, hosting and e-mail service providers
2. subcontractor, if it is necessary for the execution of your order
3. entities that provide advisory services and support for our business include law firms, accounting offices, audit service providers, and marketing service entities.
4. courier and postal service providers
5. entities conducting payment activities (banks)
6. entities engaged in debt collection activities will take action in the event of payment arrears on your part.

In addition, if necessary, your personal data may be made available to entities, bodies or institutions authorized to obtain access to data on the basis of legal provisions, such as police services, security services, courts, prosecutor's offices, as well as tax offices to the extent necessary to perform tax, settlement and accounting obligations.

Do we transfer your data to third countries?

Your data may be transferred to third countries in connection with the use of tools that store data on servers located outside the European Economic Area, in particular in the USA. Personal data is stored as part of the services of Google LLC and Microsoft Corporation, which guarantee an appropriate level of security in accordance with standard contractual clauses for the protection of personal data approved by the European Commission
